Hello

I haven't got all the photo's that I wanted but will send some more once he is doing more disabled work. We purchased Billy a 15.1hh black cob last year. He is a young horse which was the plan to bring in a new disabled horse to learn the ropes to take over from some of our older horses. He is 5yrs but is very laid back and calm, a bit to laid back some times!. The centre was hit by a horse virus a few months ago called strangles which is like human flu but can cause the glands to swell hence the strangles name. Billy was one of the horses affected but has made a full recovery it has just set us back 4 months in some of the training. He is very patient horse and has settled in well. Due to his age we are taking things slowly and has mainly been doing able bodied work. Over the summer we are going to be introducing him to more disabled work and carrying beginners.
