Student's Pride and Enjoyment with the New Chipper Shredder



This Chipper Shredder, with a powerful 13 HP Honda engine has, for the first time, enabled our students to chip branches and old vegetables into small pieces for rich composting, instead of burning them; and to chip pruned and old branches to provide weed-inhibiting and decorative mulch for flowerbeds and foot paths.

Our new Chipper Shredder is helping greatly to raise our Horticulture and Land Management work to a new level, enabling our students to create a more productive, resource-filled, welcoming and beautiful landscape at Ruskin Mill College.

The Chipper Shredder is also helping our students with their study and appreciation of ecology and land conservation.

By helping to provide these enhanced learning experiences, this work with the Chipper Shredder is helping to create improvements in the mental health and well-being of our students

And with this new addition to their technical skills and experience, students are being supported and helped to become more employable young adults.
