Your generous funding of £5,680 received on 3rd July 2019 has enabled Cumbria Youth Alliance to support 38 special needs and hard to reach young people to complete their Duke of Edinburgh's Award. Some of our young people are deaf, some have autism, some have serious learning difficulties, one has cerebral palsy and one lad is blind. This lad linked arms with his mentor for the 2 day expedition! Some have behavioural problems.
