- 1. Yes the whole community has been engaged in the preservation of their hedgehog community. There has be 100s of people regularly logging into watch the hedgehogs
- 2. The local school has had a 1 day workshop where they discovered the science and planned out the best places for the monitoring stations.
- 3. The data from the stations is being used to further the understanding of hedgehog populations and is forming the basis of an MSc project for a participating partner. It is particularly useful in exploring how the rescued population interacts with the live population.
- 4. The data is being used by the school children in their Maths, English, Science and Geography curriculums. Some of their work can be seen here
