Project Report – Additional Teaching Space

Our additional teaching space is now completed, fitted out and being used on a daily basis. The funding received from The Nineveh Trust enabled us to purchase tables, chairs, a projector and whiteboard, flooring, a kitchenette and to fit new windows and doors.

We have been able to continue to offer education to schools, albeit in school bubbles, during the pandemic and we have seen an increase in demand since restrictions have started to be lifted. Our education is particularly beneficial to those pupils of both primary and secondary school age who struggle in mainstream education for a variety of reasons. We know that the outdoor education we provide is extremely important for these pupils in terms of increasing confidence and self-esteem.

Reports from schools during the last year have evidenced improvements in school attendance and behaviour whilst in school for many of the pupils who have attended farm sessions, and they believe that this is a direct result of coming here.
