We received £1100 to improve the woodland area in our school , Christ Church Primary School, Ellesmere Port, Cheshire, after it was ruined by flooding last year. We also wanted to improve the fencing around the area and provide a place for our children to learn and for community groups

Yes it has been completed – we will maintain it through the Forest School sessions in school and through further fundraising as needed.

• If not completed yet, why not? Are plans in place to finalise the project?

We would like to invite some groups from the community in to our woodland to work with the children but we haven't been able to do this yet due to covid

• Did the funds provided by us prove adequate, or was there an over- or under-spend?

The funds were adequate for what we had in mind initially but we had to look for more funds as the pathways proved more expensive than we thought.

• How were any surplus funds used, or was further funding made available?

We used other school funds and grants to help to complete our project.

Has the project been successful and well received by the beneficiaries?

We have all benefited so much from your funding. Most of the funding went towards filling in an old and dangerous pond and on building a new fence to secure the area. Some was spent on equipment to lay bark paths around the site. As you can see from the photographs the children and myself have managed to lay our own bark paths around the site to increase access for all. This has been a wonderful experience for us all as we had to work

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together as a team. We laid the paths over a series of weeks with children of all ages helping to move the bark across the field in wheelbarrows, finding logs to line the paths and then laying the underlay and bark. This all lead to an increase in resilience, positivity and self confidence in both the staff and children - I can't tell you how proud the children are of their achievements.

Another class also took responsibility for clearing a wild flower area once the pond had been filled in and caring for it which in turn increased the number of butterflies and insects that we saw in the area over the summer and also increased the children's knowledge of the environment. We were very proud of how our woodland area has developed over the last 6 months and how much more accessible it is to all.

Unfortunately, a neighbour fly tipped various bits of rubbish including asbestos which was costly to remove. We also bought top soil and the children filled in the areas which had been cleared to make it level. We also bought a new log store and benches to provide seating for the children to enjoy the area.

We are very satisfied.

Some funding came from our school budget and we sourced other smaller grants which helped to lay the paths.
