- 15-23 degrees
- Sunlight 5:30am-6:30pm (Normal wake up time is 5am)
- 1 bedroom House shared with Honor
- Amenities: Kitchen, Tap water, Electricity, fridge/freezer, and a Stove
- 20 min walk from School
- Large markets in La Esperanza (15min drive)
- Food 500L (£15.60) per week
- **Siguapeque (1.5 hours)**
- **Gracias (2 hours)**
- **La Union (3.5 hours from Gracias)**



My Project- Abundant Life Christian School (Vida School)

- Ages 4-13
- Monday-Friday 7:40am-3pm 40 min Lessons
- Mainly Assisting, some covering
- Approx 350 students, 20-35 per class
- Bilingual School, Teaching in English
- Morning prayers, Christian songs and teachings. All staff are Catholic as most are from Honduras. We are not expected to be religious but will take part.
- 7 month intensive English course to prepare for next years lessons (starting in Jan)
- 60% on Scholarships (They essentially ask nearby schools who their smartest students are and offer them scholarships as they will most likely be below the poverty line. When they have a scholarship, they are more likely to receive a scholarship to an American university to help further their education)
- **Holidays:** 6 weeks travel at end of year, 1 week for Easter, February Break
