The project is now fully engaged with a wide section of the community, based in our flourishing community garden. We have received funding from a number of sources and continue to fundraise to support our ongoing and future work.

The Locavore Growing Project is a long term community project, the funding enabled us to continue to work with community in 2021 to reduce isolation, connect to nature and tackle food insecurity. We achieved everything that we hoped to within the available funding. The project provides significant community benefit and has generated a network of grassroots community growing in the town. We hope it will continue long into the future.

The funding awarded was less than we had requested, but we were able to secure the balance from other sources and go ahead with the work as planned. There was no over or underspend.

Further funding was received, allowing us to expand our reach and develop the garden.

The project continues to be extremely successful, both in itself and in its leading role within a local network of grassroots food activity.
